#### **BENNETTS HAVE HISTORY VS. MICHIGAN STATE**

·Tony Bennett's Ione NCAA Tournament game as a player at Green Bay came against Michigan State in 1991. The fifthseeded Spartans used a Steve Smith jump shot to avoid the upset and beat the 12th-seeded Phoenix 60-58 in a first round clash in Tucson, Ariz.

· Bennett was a staff volunteer for his father, Dick Bennett, at Wisconsin in 1999-2000 when the eighth-seeded Badgers advanced to the Final Four before losing to No. 1 seed Michigan State 53-41 in the national semifinals. The national champion Spartans went 4-0 vs. the Badgers that season.

#### **MORE ON THE HAUSER BROTHERS**

- Sam Hauser is a redshirt senior for the Cavaliers, while his brother, Joey, is a redshirt junior for the Spartans
- ·The Hauser brothers were teammates at Marquette before transferring after the 2018-19 season.
- ·The duo helped Stevens Point Area Senior High School (SPASH) to back-to-back state championships in 2015 and 2016.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. MICHIGAN STATE**

- The Cavaliers are 0-5 all-time vs. Michigan State in the series that dates back to the 1946-47 season.
- · Michigan State knocked the Cavaliers out of the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two meetings between the teams (2014 NCAA Sweet Sixteen 61-59 and 2015 NCAA second round
- · Virginia and Michigan State meet for the third time in the
- ·The Cavaliers are 0-1 against the Spartans in the Challenge. · Michigan State topped Virginia 82-75 in East Lansing, Mich.,
- in the 2002 Challenge, while the Spartans-Cavaliers 2001 Challenge game was halted due to wet floor conditions at Richmond

#### **HOO ARE THESE CAVALIERS?**

- Sam Hauser leads the team in scoring (14.5) and rebounding (6.8) and is shooting 58.5 percent from the field and 43.8 percent from 3-point range (7 of 16).
- Kihei Clark, who has come off the bench the past two games. has chipped in 7.5 points per game and leads the team with 11
- · Jay Huff is averaging 12.3 points, 6.8 rebounds and a teamleading 2.5 blocks per game.
- Trey Murphy III has reached double figures in scoring in two games and is third on the team in scoring at 10.8 points per
- Reece Beekman has six assists and team-high seven steals. · Justin McKoy has started four games and is averaging 5.0
- points and 3.8 rebounds.
- Casey Morsell (5.0 ppg), Tomas Woldetensae (41.7% 3FG) and Kody Stattmann (4.7 ppg, 2.3 rpg) have shared minutes on the perimeter, while Kadin Shedrick (3.5 ppg & 2.8 rpg) has averaged 10.5 minutes off the bench in the frontcourt.

#### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- ·Virginia is 197-45 (.814), including a 2-0 mark in 2020-21, in 15 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- · UVA was 14-3 at JPJ in 2019-20 and is 158-29 (.845), including a 124-14 (.899) mark the past nine seasons, under Bennett.
- · Virginia is an ACC-leading 65-8 (.890) in league home games over the past eight seasons. Duke is second at 64-9 (.877).
- · UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.

#### VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

• Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 280-97 (.743) mark in 12 seasons at Virginia and 349-130 (.729) career mark in 15 seasons.

· Bennett led the Cavaliers to their eighth straight season with 23 or more wins in 2019-20.

· In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.

· Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.

Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.

He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).

Bennett guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2014-19 for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins in five of the past seven seasons.

· Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).

• Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record eight straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.

 $\cdot$  He has led UVA to a school-best nine straight 20-win seasons.

· Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16, 2017-19 & 2018-20).

Bennett led UVA to nine consecutive postseason appearances (2012-19) and six consecutive NCAA tournaments (2014-19). Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons

two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19). · UVA is 136-58 (.701) in ACC play (77-20 at home & 59-38

· UVA is 136-58 (.701) in ACC play (77-20 at home & 59-38 away), 158-29 (.845) at home and 144-39 (.787) in non-conference action (81-7 at JPJ) under Bennett.

· Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .701, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Jay Huff tallied a career-high 18 points and added 11 rebounds for his fifth career double-double in Virginia's 71-64 overtime win against Kent State on Dec. 4.
- Sam Hauser added 18 points, including a huge 3-pointer in overtime, and Kihei Clark scored 14.
- Kent State's Danny Pippen sent the game to overtime with a 3-pointer at the end of regulation.
- · Virginia shot 48 percent for the game and had the edge in rebounds. 32-30.
- · Kent State, which scored 17 points off 12 UVA turnovers, was led by Michael Nuga's game-high 20 points.

#### **UVA RANKED NO. 18 IN LATEST POLLS**

· Virginia is ranked No. 18 in the latest Associated Press and USA Today Coaches' poll.

· UVA was ranked No. 4 in both preseason polls, marking its third AP preseason top-5 ranking in school history (No. 1 in 1982-83 and No. 5 in 2018-19).

 $\cdot$  UVA has been ranked in the top 25 in the preseason rankings in nine of the past 10 seasons.

· UVA has been ranked in the top 25 of the AP poll for six straight week over the past two seasons.

#### **UVA VS. THE BIG TEN CONFERENCE**

· UVA is 106-130 all-time vs. current Big Ten Conference opponents (76-107 vs. Maryland, 5-2 vs. Minnesota, 5-3 vs. Penn State, 4-0 vs. Rutgers, 4-2 vs. Wisconsin, 3-0 vs. Northwestern, 3-3 vs. Ohio State, 2-2 vs. Michigan, 2-2 vs. Purdue, 1-2 vs. Iowa, 1-2 vs. Indiana, 0-5 vs. Michigan State, 0-1 vs. Nebraska). ### **GETTING OFFENSIVE IN 2020**

- UVA has scored 70 or more points in three of its four games. • The Cavaliers scored 70 or more points twice last season (78 vs. Boston College and 73 vs. Louisville).
- $\cdot$  UVAs 89 points against Towson were its most since scoring 100 against Marshall during the 2018-19 season.

#### TRIO OF CAVALIERS MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- · Sam Hauser, Reece Beekman and Trey Murphy III have made immediate impacts for the Cavaliers in 2020-21.
- · Hauser, who played three seasons at Marquette, has reached double figures in all four games, shooting 58.5 percent from the field and 43.8 percent from 3-point range.
- · Beekman, who made his first career start vs. Saint Francis (Pa.), tallied 11 points against San Francisco and is third on the team in minutes (25.0).
- · Murphy III transferred to Virginia after the 2019-20 season and received his NCAA waiver on Nov. 24.

### NATIONAL DEFENSIVE POINTS PER GAME RANKINGS UNDER TONY BENNETT

- · Murphy III had a game-high 21 points in his UVA debut, recording his eighth career 20-point effort and tying a career-high with six 3-pointers off the bench.
- Murphy leads UVA in 3-point shooting at 53.3 percent (8 of 15).

#### **OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS**

- · UVA has limited each of its four opponents to 64 or fewer points in 2020-21.
- The Cavaliers are limiting their foes to 55.3 points (25th nationally) and 38.2 percent field goal shooting and four shot clock violations
- · In 2019-20, UVA captured its sixth NCAA scoring defense title after limiting opponents to 52.4 points per game.
- UVA limited 12 opponents to fewer than 50 points, one opponent (Duke) to 50 points and four foes to fewer than 40 points. The Cavaliers limited five opponents (Syracuse, JMU, Columbia,
- Maine and Virginia Tech) to fewer than 50 points, 29 percent or less field goal shooting and 29 percent or less 3-point shooting.

  UVA held 23 opponents below 41 percent from the field.
- The Cavaliers forced 27 shot clock violations and outrebounded 22 opponents.
   Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense seven times and finished in the top-five nationally in 11 of 14 seasons.

#### **VIRGINIA PICKED FIRST IN THE ACC**

- · Virginia was selected first in the ACC Operation Basketball 2020-21 Preseason Poll.
- The Cavaliers were named the Preseason ACC favorite for the first time since 1982-83 and second time in the 52-year history of the league poll.
- · Virginia was followed Duke, Florida State, North Carolina and Louisville in the top five.
- ACC preseason voters selected Syracuse sixth, followed by Miami, NC State, Georgia Tech and Clemson. Virginia Tech was picked 11th, while Notre Dame, Pitt, Boston College and Wake Forest rounded out the voting.
- The Cavaliers have finished at or higher than their predicted finish in 11 of the last 12 seasons.

#### HAUSER AND CLARK EARN PRESEASON ALL-ACC HONORS

- · Sam Hauser was named to the preseason All-ACC first team, while Kihei Clark was named to the second team.
- Hauser was joined on the first team by preseason ACC Player of the Year Garrison Brooks (North Carolina), Scottie Barnes (Florida State), Jalen Johnson (Duke), Aamir Simms (Clemson) and Chris Lykes (Miami).
- · Clark was joined on the preseason All-ACC second team by David Johnson (Louisville), Jose Alvarado (Georgia Tech), M.J. Walker (Florida State) and Wendell Moore Jr. (Duke).

#### WATCH ME NOW

- · Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award), Sam Hauser (Julius Erving Award) and Jay Huff (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award top-20 watch lists.
- · The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Erving Award honors the top small forward and Abdul-Jabbar the top center.
- $\cdot$  Clark was named to the Cousy Award top-20 watch list last season.
- · Hauser was one of 50 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List for Men's Player of the Year.
- · Hauser was one of 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 NABC Division I Player of the Year.
- · Hauser was one of 50 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Wooden Award, honoring the nation's top player.
