UNI QUICK NOTES

Panthers clash with Cavs

- •UNI continues its road trip through the commonwealth with a stop at No. 18 Virginia. Monday's meeting is just the second meeting all-time between the Panthers and Cavaliers, who first met back in 2013 in Charlottesville.
- •The Cavaliers were selected 3rd in the ACC preseason poll behind North Carolina and Duke, and have recorded wins over North Carolina Central and Monmouth to begin the season
- Fifth year guard Jayden Gardner was picked Second Team All-ACC Preseason after averaging 15.3 points per game last season for the Cavaliers.

Spiders inches past UNI

- •UNI struggled to shoot the ball in a 66-58 road loss to Richmond, shooting just 32.8% from the field.
- Bowen Born scored 17 points in the UNI loss as Tytan Anderson recorded his first career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds.
- UNI outscored the Spiders 17-7 off 11 Richmond turnovers.

Knighty knight

- Five Panthers made their collegiate debut as UNI rolled to a 105-49 win over the Division III Wartburg Knights. The Panthers are now 11-6 in season-opening games under head coach Ben Jacobson.
- Bowen Born led with a game-high 19 points as Landon Wolf notched 18 points his first collegiate game. Nate Heise tallied 14 points, while Trey Campbell and Drew Daniel each scored 11 points.
- UNI's 56-point margin of victory was the fourth largest in program history.

Panthers prevail in Dubuque exhibition

- Ten different Panthers scored in UNI's 84-52 exhibition win over Dubuque on Nov. 2. Tytan Anderson led with 15 points, while James Betz notched 13 points. Cole Henry recorded an 11 point, 11 rebound double-double, as a trio of Panthers scored 9 points each in Trey Campbell, Landon Wolf and Drew Daniel
- •UNI held the Spartans to just 26.7% shooting from the field in the second half while hitting 7 three-point shots in the final 20 minutes of play.

Defending the crown

- UNI enters the 2022-23 season as the reigning Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) regular season champions. The Panthers have won three outright league titles (2010, 2020, 2022) and one shared crown in 2009 with Creighton.
- Defeating Loyola-Chicago in the final game of the regular season last February, UNI's title clinched the conference championship for first time in program history on its home floor.
- Since UNI joined the MVC in 1991, the league has seen its defending champion repeat 10 times, with Wichita State achieving the feat most recently with at least a share of 4 straight titles from 2014-17.

2021-22 season in-review

- After starting the season 4-7, the Panthers won 16 of their next 21 games to finish the year with a 20-12 record, the 9th 20-win season under head coach Ben Jacobson.
- AJ Green and Noah Carter were named First and Second Team All-MVC respectively, with Bowen Born earning Sixth Man of the Year and All-Bench honors.
 Green was named the MVC's Larry Bird Player of the Year for the second time in three years, while also being named the league's co-Scholar Athlete of the Year.
- •Ben Jacobson made history as the first five time recipent of the league's Coach of the Year award.
- Despite a semifinal exit at the MVC Tournament, the Panthers earned an automatic bid to the NIT as the conference's regular season champion. UNI would defeat Saint Louis on the road in the opening round before falling to BYU in the second round.

When it heats up over 80

- •UNI is 77-9 when scoring 80 points or more under head coach Ben Jacobson.
- •The Panthers scored 80+ points in 12 games last year, with a 10-2 mark in those games.
- •UNI scored 90+ points five times last season, coming against Dubuque, St. Bonaventure, Valparaiso, Missouri State, and Loyola-Chicago.

Fresh faces

- Ben Jacobson's squad adds four new players to the 2022-23 roster in cluding a pair of Cedar Falls, lowa native in Trey Campbell and Hunter Jacobson. Both Campbell and Jacobson were part of multiple Class 4A state tournament teams during their prep careers.
- On the international front, UNI signed guard Ege Peksari out of Turkey during the off-season. Peksari, a native of Izmir, Turkey, played for the Turkish national team this summer at the U20 European Championships.
- Guard Charlie Miller comes to lowa after a prep career in North Carolina. Averaging 16.4 points per game at Lumberton High School, Miller spent the 2021-22 season playing for the Flight 22 Basketball post-graduation program.

So long, farewell

- UNI looks to make up for the loss of 5 players from last year's MVC championship team, including reigning MVC Player of the Year A.J. Green (professional basketball).
- Trae Berhow and Tywhon Pickford (graduation) departed the program, as did Noah Carter (transfer to Missouri) and Antwan Kimmons (transfer to Concordia-St. Paul).

Welcome to the Association

- Declaring for the NBA Draft last spring, former Panther AJ Green signed with the Milwaukee Bucks as an undrafted free agent this past June on a two-way deal.
- Green became the first Panther to play in an NBA regular season game on Oct. 22, 2022 with one assist in two minutes of play for the Bucks against the Houston Rockets
- Green played in 5 NBA Summer League games in Las Vegas this July, averaging 7 points per game with 9 made three-point field goals. He also notched 4.4 points a game in 5 preseason games with Milwaukee.

Tough non-conference slate

- The Panthers will play 6 home games during the non-conference schedule, including matchups with Toledo, South Florida, Northern Illinois and NIT semifinalist St. Bonaventure.
- UNI will compete in the Hall of Fame Classic in Kansas City, Mo. prior to the Thanksgiving holiday on Nov. 21-22. The Panthers will play West Coast Conference power San Francisco to open the tournament, before facing either Wichita State or Grand Canyon in the second game.
- The Panthers will take part in the inagural Legends of Basketball Chicago Hoops Showcase on Dec. 17 at the United Center in Chicago, taking on Towson for the first time in program history.

Valley realignment

- With the addition of UIC, Belmont and Murray State to the MVC in July 2022, the league will adopt a 20-game conference schedule for the first time in league history.
- UNI will take on 9 of its 11 MVC opponents both at home and on the road this season. The Panthers will face UIC (road) and Murray State (home) once.
- The Panthers have never played Belmont or Murray State before, but have split 22 games in their history against UIC in non-conference play, as well as former members of the Mid-Continent Conference (today known as the Summit League).

Returning leaders

- UNI returns three key shooters in Nate Heise (49.7%), Bowen Born (44.2%) and Austin Phyfe (53.4%). The Panthers shot 45.9% from the field a year ago.
- One of the top free throw shooting teams in the nation last season, UNI shot 78.9% from the charity striple.
 Bowen Born returns as the Panthers' top free throw shooter (90.7%).
- Grabbing 148 total rebounds (4.8 per game) last season, Nate Heise returns looking to be a key piece in the UNI defense in the quest for an MVC title repeat.
- Heise also led the Pantthers with 34 steals a year ago.
 Despite limited minutes, Austin Phyfe posted a teamhigh 13 blocks.

Top 10 on UNI's all-time list

- Austin Phyfe currently holds the highest career field goal shooting percentage in program history, shooting 60.4% from the field during his career.
- Bowen Born ranks 4th in career free throw percentage (85.2%) in UNI program history.

Welcome to the office

- Gameli Ahelegbe joined the UNI coaching staff this past May, suceeding Erik Crawford, who departed the program to join the staff at lowa State this past spring.
- Former University of Dubuque guard Carter Stevens joined the Panther staff as graduate manager this offseason, filling the role held by Marc Sonnen, who is now an assistant coach at the University of Minnesota-Duluth.

New Voice of the Panthers

- For the first time since 1993, Panther fans will hear a new voice on the radio as J.W. Cox takes over as the play-by-play voice of UNI men's basketball.
- Coming from St. Cloud State in Minnesota, Cox suceeds longtime Panther broadcaster Gary Rima, who retired after 29 years on the air.

Hall of Fame team

- This past September, the 1963--64 State College of lowa (SCI) Panther men's basketball team was inducted into the UNI Athletics Hall of Fame.
- Champions of the North Central Conference and NCAA Midwest Region, SCI reached the NCAA College Division (now Division II) Final Four, marking the deepest postseason run in program history.
- Four members of the 1963-64 team remain in the top-100 on the program's all-time scoring list, led by Pete Spoden (1959-64), who is tied for 17th all-time with 1,239 career points.

Family connections

- Landon Wolf's brother Logan plays wide receiver for the UNI football team. His cousin, Cynthia plays for the Panther women's basketball team.
- Charlie Miller's grandfather, Eldon, served as UNI's head men's basketball coach from 1986-98, helping the Panthers reach the 1990 NCAA Tournament.
- Michael Duax's father Bob played football at UNI in the 1980s
- Chase Courbat's grandfather John Martin was part of the UNI men's basketball program from 1967-70, scoring 1,027 career points. He was inducted into the UNI Athletics Hall of Fame in 2008.
- Hunter Jacobson is the eldest son of Panther head coach Ben Jacobson.
- Austin Phyfe's father Steve played at UNI from 1987-90, helping the Panthers reach their first NCAA Tournament as a Division I program in 1990. His sister Aftin was also a member of the UNI swimming & diving team from 2013-17.
- Assistant coach Gameli Ahelegbe's younger brother Kwadzo played for the Panthers from 2006-10 and was part of two MVC championship and NCAA Tournament teams, including the 2010 NCAA Sweet Sixteen roster.

MVC EXPANSION





Ben Jacobson

Head Coach 16th Season Univ. of North Dakota '94 @CoachJake_UNI

University of Northern Iowa head coach Ben Jacobson personifies class and dignity on and off the floor as the leader of the Panther men's basketball team. He is UNI men's basketball program's all-time wins leader through 16 seasons. Jacobson has averaged 20 wins per season at UNI.

This past summer, Jacobson was awarded a two-year contract extension that will run through the 2028-29 season. He is a four-time MVC Coach of the Year and ranks fourth all-time in the MVC coaching victories (321) and third in league-only wins (174).

Jacobson is the only coach in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference to have recorded two wins over two different No. 1-ranked teams (Kansas, North Carolina).

Under Jacobson, UNI placed in the top half of the MVC during 12 seasons. Prior to him joining the staff in 2001, the Panthers had only finished in the upper half twice since joining the conference in 1991. At one point, UNI rolled off 14 consecutive top-half finishes beginning in 2004.

Jacobson has guided the Panthers to postseason play in seven seasons including four trips to the NCAA Tournament (2009, 2010, 2015, and 2016). UNI reached the Sweet 16 in 2010 following wins over UNLV and No. 1-ranked Kansas. UNI competed in the 2012 National Invitation Tournament and scored a first-round road victory over Saint Joseph's. The Panthers made their second NIT appearance in program history in 2022 with a first-round road win at Saint Louis. UNI also took part in the 2011 and 2013 CollegeInsider.com Tournament. UNI advanced to the semifinals of the 2013 CIT. The Panthers scored a 71-54 win over Wvoming in the 2015 NCAA Tournament to secure the fourth all-time tournament victory for the program. UNI produced its fifth NCAA Tournament win with a 75-72 triumph over Texas in the 2016 tournament.

Ten Panthers earned First Team All-MVC, nine earned Second Team All-MVC, and nine earned

Third Team or Honorable Mention All-MVC so far in his tenure. Jacobson has also seen UNI honored with four Larry Bird MVC Player of the Year selections in Adam Koch (2010), Seth Tuttle (2015), and AJ Green (2020, 2022).

The Panthers have picked up 30 Academic All-Conference honors in Jacobson's time as head coach. Adam Koch (2010), Nate Buss (2015), and AJ Green (2020, 2022) each earned MVC Scholar-Athlete of the Year recognition.

The Panthers have had many make immediate impacts during Jacobson's tenure with 15 spots claimed on either the MVC All-Newcomer or MVC All-Freshmen teams dating back to the 2006-07 season. Freshman of the Year honorees have included Seth Tuttle (2012), AJ Green (2019), and Bowen Born (2021).


