FOR OPENERS

- No. 13 Virginia (9-2, 4-0 ACC) returns to action against Georgia Tech (7-3, 3-1 ACC) on Jan. 23.
- As of Jan. 21, Virginia ranks second nationally in turnovers per game (8.2), third in personal fouls per game (13.3), fifth in assist/turnover ratio (1.71), seventh in free throw percentage (80.2), eighth in scoring defense (59.4) and 14th in field goal percentage (50.7).
- The Cavaliers have a five-game winning streak and have started 5-0 in the ACC for the first time since starting 12-0 in 2017-18.
- UVA has a 13-game ACC winning streak dating back to 2019-20.

ALL-TIME VS. GEORGIA TECH

- Virginia is 43-40 all-time vs. Georgia Tech, including a 24-11 record in Charlottesville, in the series that dates back to 1947-48.
- The Cavaliers have a six-game winning streak in the series, including a 63-58 road win last season.
- UVA has held Georgia Tech to 58 points or less during the six-game winning streak in the series.
- Virginia is 14-2 in its last 16 games against Georgia Tech, including a 13-2 mark under head coach Tony Bennett.

HOW ARE THESE CAVALIERS?

- Kihei Clark, Sam Hauser and Jay Huff lead the Cavaliers into action against Georgia Tech.
- Clark, who has recorded 14 points and 4.3 assists per game the past six games, has averaged 10.9 points and team-high 3.7 assists.
- Hauser leads the team in scoring (13.8 ppg) and rebounding (7.5 rpg), and is shooting 49.6 percent from the field and 37.5 percent from 3-point range (21 of 56).
- Huff leads the team in blocked shots (2.3 bpg) and is second in scoring (12.8 ppg) and rebounding (5.9 rpg).
- Trey Murphy III (11.1 ppg) leads the team in 3-pointers (26) and 3-point percentage (52%).
- Rookie Reece Beekman has a team-high 19 steals, 29 assists and 29 rebounds.
- Casey Morsell (6.7 ppg) returned from a two-game absence with a season-high 15 points on 6 of 7 shooting (3 of 3 3FGs) vs. Notre Dame.
- Justin McKoy (4.2 ppg and 3.4 rpg), Tomas Woldetensae (41.4% 3FG) and Kadin Shedrick (3.5 ppg & 2.9 rpg) have added depth, while Kody Statmann (4.7 ppg, 2.3 rpg) remains sidelined with a non-COVID-19 related cardiac issue.

UVA RANKED NO. 13 IN LATEST AP POLL

- Virginia is ranked No. 13 in the latest Associated Press poll.
- UVA has been ranked in the top 25 of the AP poll for 11 straight weeks over the past two seasons.
- UVA was ranked No. 4 in both preseason polls, marking its third AP preseason top-5 ranking in school history (No. 1 in 1982-83 and No. 5 in 2018-19).
- UVA has been ranked in the top 25 in the preseason rankings in nine of the past 10 seasons.

LAST TIME VS. THE YELLOW JACKETS

- Jay Huff scored 17 points and added six blocked shots to lead Virginia to a 63-58 win at Georgia Tech on Jan. 18, 2020.
- Mamadi Diakite added 17 points and six rebounds, and Kihei Clark chipped in seven assists as Virginia ended its longest losing streak (3 games) since 2016-17.
- Tomas Woldetensae had a career-high three steals and drilled a trio of 3-pointers off the bench.
- Virginia shot 47.2 percent (25 of 53) and tied a season high with nine blocked shots.

LAST TIME OUT

- Sam Hauser and Tomas Woldetensae led five players in double figures with 14 points apiece as then-No. 18 Virginia (9-2, 5-0) routed No. 12 Clemson 85-50 on Jan. 16.
- Virginia started the game on an 18-2 run, drilled 15 3-pointers and outrebounded the Tigers 33-21 in the win.
- Woldetensae had season highs in points and 3-pointers (4) as the Cavaliers scored 80 or more points in back-to-back ACC games for the first time since 2006-07.
- Trey Murphy III added 13 points and Kihei Clark and Jay Huff each added 12, respectively.
- Huff added seven rebounds and career-high five assists.
- Virginia shot a season-high 60.7 percent, including 55.6 percent from downtown.

GETTING OFFENSIVE IN 2020

- UVA has scored 70 or more points in eight games (7-1) and its 73.5 points per game are most under Tony Bennett, and best since 76.8 ppg in 2007-08.
- The Cavaliers scored 70 or more points twice last season (78 vs. Boston College and 73 vs. Louisville).
- UVA's 89 points against Towson were its most since scoring 100 against Marshall during the 2018-19 season.
- UVA ranks seventh nationally in free throw percentage (80.2%) and 14th in field goal percentage (50.7%). Both marks rank first in the Bennett era at UVA.

VIRGINIA HEAD COACH TONY BENNETT

- Three-time National and four-time ACC Coach of the Year Tony Bennett has a 286-98 (.745) mark in 12 seasons at Virginia and 355-131 (.730) career mark in 15 seasons.
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to their eighth straight season with 23 or more wins in 2019-20.
- In 2018-19, Bennett led the Cavaliers to their first NCAA national championship, a share of their ninth ACC regular-season title and school-record 35 wins.
- Bennett became the 80th active Division I head coach to win his 300th career game against Marshall on Dec. 31, 2018.
- Bennett was named the USBWA Henry Iba National Coach of the Year for the third time in 2018 to rank second all-time behind legendary John Wooden, who captured the award six times.
- He has led UVA to outright ACC regular-season and tournament championships in the same season two times (2014 and 2018).
- Bennett guided UVA to six straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2014-19 for the first time in school history and has led UVA to 29 or more wins in five of the past seven seasons.
- Bennett is the sixth coach in ACC history to win at least three outright ACC regular-season titles (Frank McGuire, Vic Bubas, Dean Smith, Mike Krzyzewski and Roy Williams).
- Bennett has led UVA to a school-best 16 or more ACC wins in four of the last six seasons and a school-record eight straight seasons with 11 or more ACC wins.
- He has led UVA to a school-best nine straight 20-win seasons.
- Bennett guided UVA to a school-record 89 wins over three seasons two times (2014-16, 2017-19 & 2018-20).
- Bennett led UVA to nine consecutive postseason appearances (2012-19) and six consecutive NCAA tournaments (2014-19).
- Bennett led the Cavaliers to 30 wins in back-to-back seasons two times (2014-2015 and 2018-19).
- UVA is 141-58 (.709) in ACC play (79-20 at home & 62-38 away), 159-29 (.846) at home and 145-40 (.784) in non-conference action (82-7 at JPJ) under Bennett.
- Bennett ranks fifth all-time in winning percentage at .709, among ACC head coaches with 100 or more ACC regular-season wins.

TRANSFERS MAKING IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- Transfers Sam Hauser and Trey Murphy III have made immediate impacts for the Cavaliers in 2020-21.
- Hauser, who played three seasons at Marquette, leads UVA in scoring (13.8 ppg) and rebounding (7.5 rpg).
- Hauser has reached double figures in 10 games, including a season-high 19 points against Towson, 18 vs. Kent State and 17 at Boston College.
- Hauser registered three straight double-doubles (13 points & 10 rebounds at Notre Dame, 16 points & 11 rebounds vs. Wake Forest and 17 points and 10 rebounds at Boston College).
- Murphy III transferred to Virginia from Rice after the 2019-20 season and received his NCAA waiver on Nov. 24.
- Murphy III had a game-high 21 points in his UVA debut, recording his eighth career 20-point effort and tying a career-high with six 3-pointers off the bench.
- Murphy III, who has reached double figures in seven games, led the Cavaliers with 15 points vs. William & Mary.
- Murphy leads UVA in 3-point shooting at 52 percent (26 of 50).

OUR DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

- UVA has limited nine opponents to 64 or fewer points.
- The Cavaliers are limiting their foes to 59.4 points per game, which ranks ninth nationally.
- UVA has forced nine shot clock violations.
- UVA has limited eight opponents to 40 percent or less field goal shooting and outrebounded eight opponents.
- Bennett-coached teams have led the nation in scoring defense seven times and finished in the top-five nationally in 11 of 14 seasons.

FIVE CAVALIERS AMONG ACC LEADERS

- As of Jan. 21, Jay Huff ranks second in field goal percentage (.622) and second in blocked shots (2.3).
- Sam Hauser ranks seventh in the ACC in rebounding (7.5), ninth in field goal percentage (.496) and 17th in scoring (13.8).
- Trey Murphy III ranks sixth in made 3-pointers (2.4).
- Kihei Clark ranks fifth in assist/turnover ratio (2.1) and eighth in assists (3.6).
- Reece Beekman ranks seventh in steals (1.7).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Virginia is 200-45 (.816), including a 5-0 mark in 2020-21, in 15 seasons at John Paul Jones Arena.
- UVA was 14-3 at JPJ in 2019-20 and is 159-29 (.846), including a 125-14 (.899) mark the past nine seasons, under Bennett.
- Virginia is an ACC-leading 67-8 (.893) in league home games over the past nine seasons. Duke is second at 66-9 (.880).
- UVA has won 11 or more home games for 11 straight seasons.

WATCH ME NOW

- Kihei Clark (Bob Cousy Award), Sam Hauser (Julius Erving Award) and Jay Huff (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award) were named to Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame preseason award top-20 watch lists.
- The Cousy Award honors the nation's top point guard, while the Erving Award honors the top small forward and Abdul-Jabbar the top center.
- Clark was named to the Cousy Award top-20 watch list last season.
- Hauser was one of 50 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List for Men's Player of the Year.
- Hauser was one of 20 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 NABC Division I Player of the Year.
- Hauser was one of 50 players named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Wooden Award, honoring the nation's top player.
- Hauser was one of 25 players named to the Wooden Award midseason watch list on Jan. 5.

UVA VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- UVA is 1-1 vs. ranked opponents, dropping a 98-75 decision to top-ranked Gonzaga and defeating then-No. 12 Clemson.
- The Cavaliers were 4-2 against ranked opponents in 2019-20 (1-2 vs top-5 foes and all six are top-10 foes).
- UVA is 47-37 against ranked opponents in the Tony Bennett era.
- UVA's 11 ranked wins in 2018-19 marked a school record.
- UVA is 160-332 vs. ranked opponents since 1953-54.
- UVA is 1-31 all-time vs. No. 1-ranked opponents (86-73 win vs. No. 1 North Carolina on Jan. 30, 1986).

2019-20 IN REVIEW

• Virginia finished the season with a 23-7 overall record and tied for second in the ACC with a 15-5 record.
 • The 2020 ACC and NCAA tournaments were canceled due to the coronavirus.
 • The Cavaliers won 23 or more games for the eighth consecutive season.
 • UVA won 15 or more league games for the third straight season and fifth overall.
 • UVA finished the season on an eight-game winning streak.




